



Connection to the eduroam wireless network

Eduroam is an international roaming wireless internet access network developed for the international academic and research community. It connects a multitude of academic institutions and offers free internet access. Users from all over Europe are able to use the services offered by institutions through the eduroam infrastructure. Thus, users visiting other institutions in Greece or abroad that are members of eduroam can use the free internet access by using the codes provided by their institution. Similarly, when a member of the University of Peloponnese visits a foreign institution participating in eduroam (<https://www.eduroam.org/?p=where>), they can access the internet using their personal account from the University of Peloponnese.

Through its policy, eduroam ensures the secure transmission of user data and defines a framework of cooperation between institutions, which favours the exchange of services and facilitates users when they are in foreign institutions. Internet access via eduroam is possible for all laptops, tablets, smart phones, etc., and is secure, without restrictions. The connection to the eduroam network (<https://cat.eduroam.org/>) is allowed using Wi-Fi and not wired Ethernet, i.e. with a network cable, and is made using your institutional account (username@uop.gr or username@go.uop.gr), where you must enter your full e-mail address and not just your username.
